## Call for Papers

### Issue no.1: 'Justice and Equality'

We are pleased to announce that the very first issue of the Journal of Early Career Research in Humanities and Social Sciences will focus on the theme "Justice and Equality". Due to the nature of the journal accepting submissions from a wide range of disciplines, this could be interpreted as how diverse citizenries and societies define moral action and socio-political equity. These definitions themselves, of course, vary greatly, and are often subject to change, allowing further scope for comparisons and criticisms of "Justice and Equality" on a global scale. Such notions have the capacity to unite but are also the terrain of conflict and contestation. Social Sciences, Arts and Humanities research reveal historical and contemporary meanings and applications of "Justice and Equality" in different fora. This shines a light on politics today, sustaining civil society movements, broadening and diversifying our reckonings with both phenomena.

Potential research topics may include (but are not limited to): How have historical actors understood, fashioned and deployed notions of justice and equality in print and in action? How far do conceptions of justice, fairness, equality and inclusivity vary across time and Space? Migrants' experience of access to UK higher education. How are justice and equality portrayed in written form? In the current political climate, how much of a priority are the concepts of justice and equality in policies that we see in action?

Submissions should be between 2000-5000 words in length and referenced in APA format. Contributors should also be aware that before publication they will need to sign and return ethics (if relevant) and copyright forms. The Journal of Early Career Research in Humanities and Social Sciences is an online journal, so your work will appear on our new website with the hope to obtain an ISSN.

We will also be accepting work that falls under the general theme, so if you have something in mind that does not quite fit the theme but is close please do send it through. Do note that there will be future issues, so if it does not make this issue it might be of use to shape the next theme and be more fit to publish there.

We will be welcoming submissions to [jecrhss@gmail.com](mailto:jecrhss@gmail.com) until 15/06/2019. These will then be peer reviewed and returned with suggestions with the aim to be published on a brand new website in September 2019.
